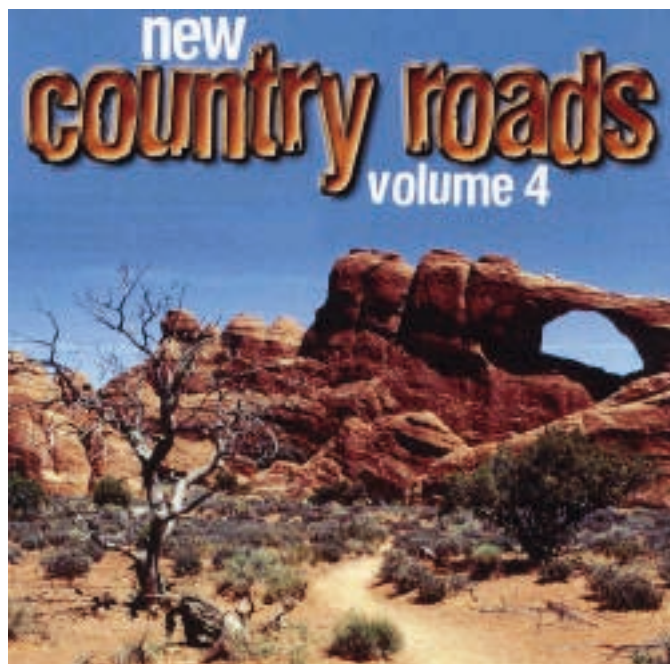

Music out of passion. Bernhard Mikulski, company founder, put this idea into play in 1971: on the Southern edge of the Westerwald, he began with Pop-Import his own company that he continually extended into an independent recording medium sales department. In 1992 the company was renamed ZYX Music and is considered today as the leading independent recording medium enterprise in Europe. Since the death of the company founder and company leader in 1997, his wife, Christa Mikulski, has taken over the leading role of the company, to which a press shop as well as music publishers belong. Aside from the headquarters in Hessian Merenberg, there are branches in almost all European countries as well as in the USA. More than 250 employees work worldwide to ensure the success of the products – engaged and creatively.

It was just a question of time until the attempt to establish the Rubric Country Music into a label was successful. Through uncountable releases, ZYX Records was able to make Country Music more well-known. In order to offer the artists an additional platform, top management sparked the idea of bringing a Sampler-Series into being. Based on the classic „Country Roads“, „New Country Roads“ was brought to the market. In the meantime, the fourth edition has appeared. Appearing, this time around, are CCB, Sivert Bjordal, Ricky Dean Morgan, Ann-Martia, Kevin Henderson, Crea, Stars'N'Bars, Mat Wegner, Dallas Wayne, Kelly Lang, Alicija Boncol, Hermann Lammers Meyer, Alicija Boncol und Tequila Sunrise, although Steve H. and Melbra Rai are in the shadows of Tequila Sunrise. Hermann Lamers Meyer and David Frizzell's duet is to be brought to attention. Hermann Lamers Meyer used his long term friendship with David Frizzell and convinced the living legends to produce a duet with him for the sampler. Detailed interviews with different artists appear on the sampler such as Ricky Dean Morgan, Steve Hamelink and Kelly Lang who are in CountryHome again. Otherwise the sampler is none other than what counts for all other samplers: a good beginning.
